- 2. **Payments**: All requests (troops, encampments, etc.) can be paid in full (Check or Credit Card) or you can submit **half** the fees with the **balance due 6 weeks** before your rental date. If your date is less than 6 weeks, full payment is due with rental form.
- 3. **Damage Deposit:** Please include Credit Card information or separate refundable damage deposit check for \$25.00 per site, max \$100.00. Cards are not charged and checks are returned provided no damage occurs.
- 4. **Training**: Submit copies of First Aid/CPR certification if training not on file with GSEM. For boating and/or swimming please submit copies of certifications for activities planned.
- 5. **Troop Cancellation or Postponement**: Written notice of cancellation must be received 6 weeks prior to your date to receive a refund. Troops who want to postpone a reservation due to low enrollment and reschedule must give 4 weeks' notice in order to transfer payment to a new date. Less than 4 weeks' notice will result in GSEM keeping half of the payment for the postponed event.
