

Girl Scout Give Thanks-

Choose 1 or 2 before we eat

When eating a meal with your Girl Scout troop, it is tradition to stop and reflect how thankful you are for the food you are about to eat. Grace is a Kaper of the Girl Scout Hostesses. The Hostesses choose which grace they would like to lead before the troop eats their meal. If it is a new Grace for the troop the Hostesses may sing it first to teach the rest of the girls. Then, in unison, the other girls and volunteers repeat them. Only after grace is done, may people begin to eat. Remember to be respectful to religious beliefs of all troop members when choosing a grace and modify the words if needed. Here are a few graces to choose from.

JOHNNY APPLE SEED

The Lord is good to me,

And so I thank the Lord,

For giving me the things I need.

The sun, the rain, and the apple seed. The Lord is good to me.

MORNING IS HERE

Morning is here, the board is spread,

Thanks be to God, who gives us bread. (morning, noontime, snack time, evening, etc.)

Clean-Up - Saturday AM

Check Bathrooms

Check toilets/sinks for cleanliness and wipe them down with sanitizing wipes. Wear gloves!

Saturday Breakfast -

Hand out Cereal girls brought from home

Get out milk & juice for Hostess to serve

Place yogurts (squeezable) on table

Place apples & bananas & oranges/
clementines in big bowl

Place Mini Muffins out on tables

Put table cloth on tables.

Place napkins, forks and plates on table.

Set out mustard, ketchup for all to use

Make a centerpiece out of nature. (Do not pick anything that is living.)

Place Pretzels/chips on table

Ask people what they would like to drink, milk or water and place them on the table.

Saturday Breakfast

Put table cloth on tables.

Place napkins, forks and plates on table.

Hand out drinks Milk/juice/water

Choose a Giving Thanks Poem to read before Breakfast

Friday Night

Clean-up - **ALL**

Purple - Clear all trash & recycle paper

Pink - wipe down tables

Blue - Wash all cooking items

Saturday Breakfast

Put away any leftovers. Place them in baggies and put in brown bags with our troop number on them and place them in the fridge.

Wash containers used for serving,

Make sure all trash is thrown away and all recyclables have been collected and put into a trash bag.

Wipe down the table.

Fire Building/Tending

Friday Dinner -

Collect tinder, kindling and rocks.

Assist the fire tender (adult) with building the fire.

Help maintain the fire, add tinder or kindling as directed by fire tender.

Clean-Up - Saturday AM

Inside Cabins

Return mattresses/cots/tables/chairs to original locations.

Wipe down the kitchen counters.

Sweep all of the floors in the cabin.

Mop the floors, if necessary.

Pack all remaining supplies.

Everyone check for personal belongings.

Remove all food from the refrigerator and place in the coolers. (Do this last - during final cabin check-out.)

Clean-Up - Saturday AM

Clean Outside the Cabin

Remove leftover firewood from brown bags and pile neatly by the fire ring.

Pick up all paper and trash.

Place all trash bags in garbage containers.

Place all recyclables in recyclable container.
